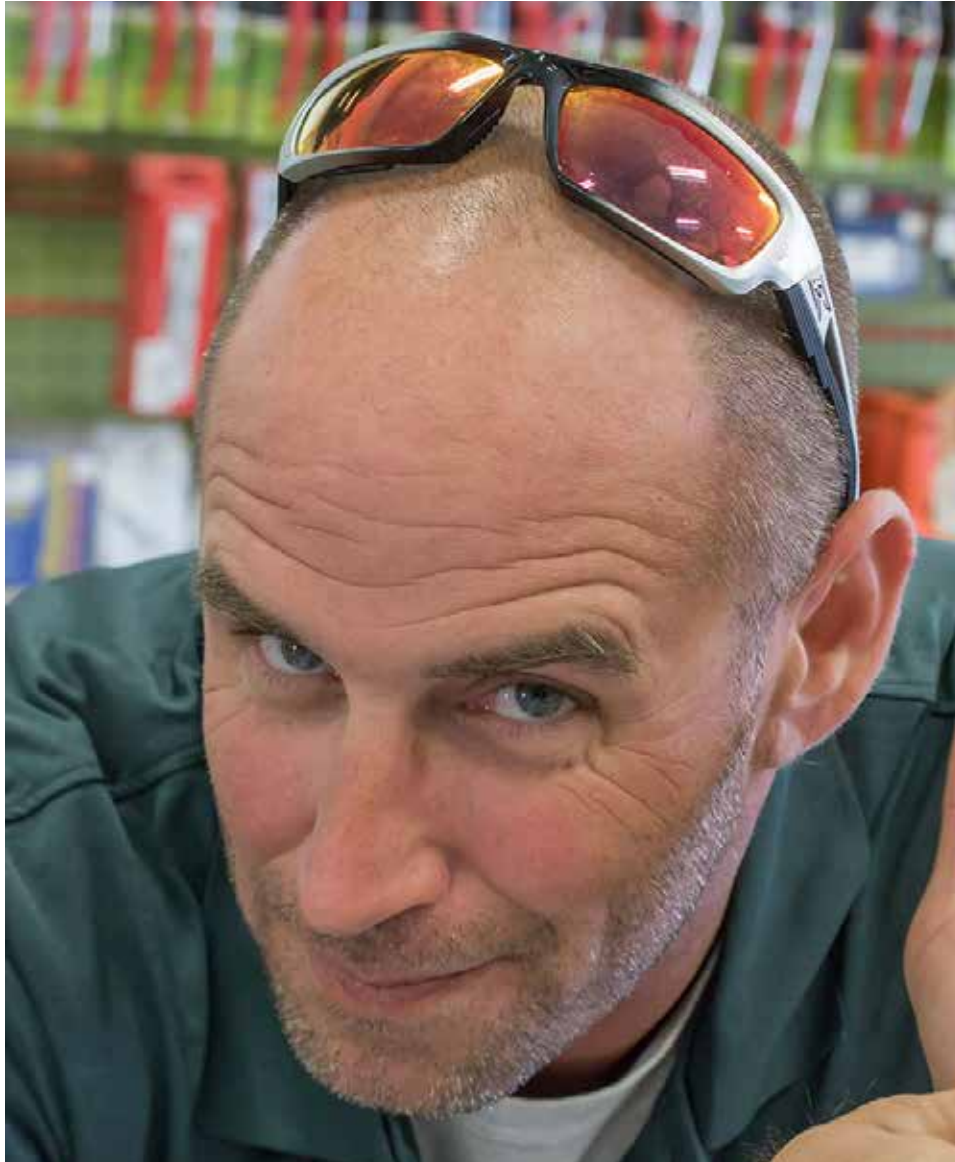
Contractor's customer: "There's no leaves on my maple! It's dead!"
