

Carnations for Mom

A lovely lawn specimen or accent tree, Prunus 'Kwanzan' puts on an incredible display. This early season bloomer flowers with an abundance of bright pink flowers that are very similar to carnations. These flowers appear on the bronzy-red new growth. With the red tint persisting in the bark year round, Kwanzan becomes a year round interest tree in any landscape.



Kwanzan cherry forms a medium sized tree, reaching twenty to twenty five feet tall in maturity. Its vase shaped structure keeps a quite upright appearance, even once it reached its full width of fifteen to twenty feet. This cherry is a moderate rate grower that does require some regular pruning to ensure that it always looks its best. Regular watering in the summer months will also help this plant look its best all year, and give you its best in the spring.
