Evergreens are just around the corner... Place your order now.

Well, it's almost August, and the selection in the evergreen block has been limited for quite a while. Our sales staff has been working their way through our above-ground inventory and guarding your selections with risk sometimes it seems to life and limb. It is not uncommon to hear on the radio "I have a 7-8' whatever tagged with green and white stripe, no name, no date I'm loading it on a customer's truck..." followed by "No touchy!"



Well, I am happy to say that the harvesting of fresh evergreen material for your projects is just around the corner. It usually starts the first or second week of August, depending on heat and soil moisture. Colorado Spruce and Austrian Pine are the first to be dug, followed by Blackhills Spruce (White Spruce), Norway Spruce and then onto Concolor, White Pine and Hemlock. Conifers at this time of year tend to have their best color and are in their prime, not just coming out of a very hard winter.

We typically have a no-tag policy on fresh stock at this time of year to keep the material moving. So if you have that project that you have been waiting to get started or finished... see one of our sales staff and they will be glad to book your order. Then, when it arrives, it gets unloaded off the truck, loaded onto yours and installed on your project. So hang on to your hats, here we go into fall.
