

## Extra Danger of Frost Damage to Plants This Spring!

Please be aware we're running a greater risk than usual this spring of frost damage to all plants. Because of our very mild winter this season, coupled with expected temperatures recently in the 50s, a cold snap later this month could cause significant damage to early flowers and leaves.

Plants will re-leaf if early leaves are blackened by frost. Frost damaged flowers will be fine next season. Knowing this, you can be prepared when your customer calls and complains that their tree is "dying", or did not flower. The average recovery time for frost blackened leaves will be four to six weeks.
