Grow your own SUPER FOOD.

Blueberries can be an attractive and delicious addition to a home landscape. I prefer this Super Food over Kale anytime.

They have a few specific requirements to allow them to thrive in a landscape. A location with full sun and moist, well drained soil is a good start. The soil pH must be 4 to 4.5. Incorporate granular sulfur (3-4 lbs per 100 sq ft) and generous amounts of peat moss to the top 4 inches of soil. After planting add 1-1.5 lbs aluminum sulfate and 2-3 lbs of 10-10-10 per 100 sq ft. Do not apply directly on the roots. This a good formula to apply on a yearly basis.

Mulching and regular irrigation, 1-2 inches per week are crucial due to the shallow and fiberous roots. A soaker hose would be a good idea.
