With just a little lime please...

Just as other plants are starting to drop out of flower these babies are starting to kick it into full gear. I am talking about Hydrangea paniculata 'Limelight'. This plant starts to flower about the beginning of August with beautiful lime green flowers born in large panicles. As they age they fade to white then to an off pink color that will hold up late into the fall. They are zone 3 hardy (I recently saw some flowering in the upper reaches of Canada while on vacation). They get large if they are unpruned and can end up to be in the 8' x 8' range. Good news is that they take to pruning well and can be easily maintained in the 5' range.

Still finding this a bit to large for the space that you have to work with, or just lazy like me and HATE to prune, then check out Hydrangea paniculata 'Little Lime'. It grows to about 4' x 4' and flowers just as profusely as it's larger brother.



But wait, you say "I am not looking for a shrub, I need a small ornamental tree for my project" - they come on a standard as well. Makes a great small ornamental tree that can be contained in a small space.

While you are here check out some of the other Hydrangea paniculata cultivars that are in stock at CPC, such as Vanilla Strawberry and Quick Fire, just to expand that plant palette a little again.
